Bard College professor and concert organist Renée Anne Louprette shares a lively multi-media presentation of her 2022 Fulbright research project about historic pipe organs throughout the enchanting country of Romania. She will introduce us to the culturally diverse region of Transylvania and fascinating instruments from the Baroque era through the 19th century that have been rescued and restored by artisans in the Carpathian Mountain region of Braşov.

Following the lecture, all are invited to take a short tour of the St. James pipe organ (built by George Bozeman Jr. & Co. in 1991) and then to a reception in the Parish Hall featuring a sampling of Romanian wines and culinary delights, hosted by Ms. Louprette.
